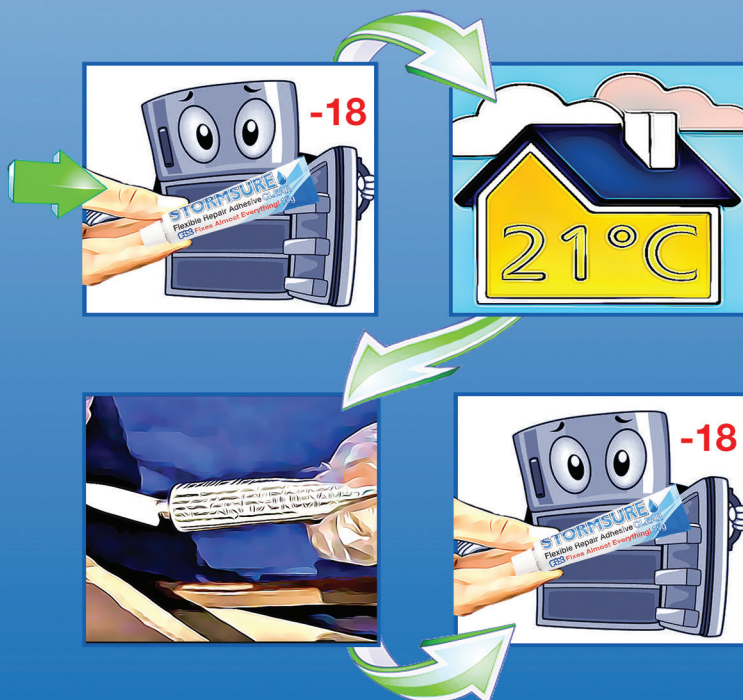
Storing partly used tubes of Stormsure Flexible Repair Adhesive

We advise users to store part - used tubes in the freezer. This advice is written in the instruction leaflet and also on the tube. The shelf life of un-opened tubes is very long. I have some office samples which are over 15 years old and are perfectly useable.

Stormsure glue cures when it comes into contact with water vapour. There is enough vapour in the air to start the curing reaction. So, as soon as it comes into contact with the air, the curing process will start. It is a chain reaction, once it has started curing it can not be stopped. Sometimes a small air bubble can get closed inside the tube and this is sufficient to start the reaction. So, before replacing the cap, squeeze the glue to the top of the tube neck to squeeze the air out. Then screw on the cap. A way to negate the curing process is;

Freezing the glue makes the glue go hard and waxy which prevents the curing process from starting. Or halts it if it has started. To use the glue again just leave it in a warm place or put the tube in a hot cup of water until it has melted, feels squidgy and reached room temperature then it should work as normal. The freezing process can be repeated over and over again.

We also sell a pack of three small 5g tubes which are designed as single use tubes, so that you can use one tube and still have two more for another day.
